

In the Matter of Land at the West and South of the Cricket Ground at Frensham, Waverley D

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land at the West and South of the Cricket Ground at Frensham, Waverley D being the land comprised in the Land Section (Register Unit No. CL 439 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freshold owner of any unregistered part of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Guildford on 17 October 1979.

Mr T R Lloyd, Chairman and Mr C Stagg, Clerk to the Frensham Parish Council appeared but they had no information as to the ownership of any part of the land in question which is unregistered.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of any unregistered part of the lad, and such land will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state asset for the decision of the High Court.
