



In the Matter of Land in Run Common Road and
Upper House Road, Womersh, Surrey

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 180 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 360 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 15 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 3 May 1979. The hearing was attended by Miss A M Deacon, Solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council, the successor authority of the former Hambledon Rural District Council, the applicant for the registration, Mr G Wells, Solicitor, on behalf of the Executors of the late Lord Tangle, whose application was noted under Section 4(4) of the Commons Registration Act 1965, and Mr D Angus, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council.

The land comprised in the Register Unit is traversed by metalled carriageways, which it was agreed by the parties should not be included in the Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modifications—namely the exclusion of the metalled carriageways.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
