## DIFFISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.151 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 169 made by Surrey County Council and Objection No. 311 made by C M Thresh and others and noted in the Register on 1 September 1970 and 8 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 5 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of the County Council and by Mr A R Hart, Solicitor, of Waverley District Council, successor Authority to Hambleton RIC, applicant for the registration.

The District Council did not resist the objections and agreed to the cancellation of the registration which, accordingly, I refuse to confirm.

Tham required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to emplain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in roint of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to bim, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
