

In the Matter of Part of Chelsham Common near to Chelsham Place and the junction of Limpsfield Road and Sunny Bank, Tandridge D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 476 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 290 made by Mr A R Pawell and noted in the Register on 7 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Oxted on 25 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr Oakey, Chairman of Chelsham and Farleigh Parish Council, which claimed to be successor to Mr Pewell as owner of the land, and by Mr K Paul of Highlands Farm (Chelsham) Ltd, the applicant for registration.

Mr Paul produced two letters containing statements as to past grazing on the land and after hearing their contents, Mr Oakey said that the Parish Council was prepared to withdraw the Objection. In these circumstances, I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
