

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No: 236/D/288

In the Matter of pieces of land at Littlehurst Farm (part of Stringer's Common), Worplesdon, Guildford District, Surrey

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL449 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 567 made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 26 May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 27 November 1979. At the hearing Surrey County Council were represented by Mr B Cutter a principal solicitor with the Council.

The registration was made on the application of Guildford Rural District Council. The grounds of the Objection are that the land coloured pink on the attached plan was not common land at the date of registration; the land so coloured comprises three strips along the south sides of the pieces of land in this Register Unit.

Mr Cotter drew my attention to a letter dated 30 October 1979 and sent by the Guildford Borough Council to Surrey County Council in which their Clerk and Solicitor says that he has consulted the Farish Council and they and he are prepared to agree to the area of land objected to being removed from the Register.

Having regard to this letter, I confirm the registration with the modification that there be removed from the Register the land coloured pink on the said Objection plan.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
