

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/550-55\$

In the Matter of Winterfold Heath and land at the Warren, Wonersh and Cranleigh

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 216 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by two Objections, No. 13 made by J D Kerr for the Bray Settled Estates and noted in the Register on 8 November 1968 and No. 26 by the Ministry of Agriculture noted in the Register on 6 May 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 4 February 1981. At the hearing the Bray Settled Estates were represented by Mr P Stone, of the firm of Crow, Watkin and Watkin, Solicitors: the Minister of Agriculture by Mr Turner, Solicitor: and Waverley District Council (successor to Hambledon RDC) by Mr R A Hart, Solicitor.

The registration was made on the application of Hambledon RDC. The two Objections relate to the same part (not the whole) of the land in question, and Mr Hart had no evidence to offer in support of the registration. In these circumstances I shall exclude from the registration the part of the land shown on the plans accompanying the Objections, and confirm the registration modified by this exclusion.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
