

OMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 27/U/27

In the Matter of Wallsend Village Green and Burns Close Recreation Ground, both in Wallsend Borough, Northumberland

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Wallsend illage Green and Burns Close Recreation Ground both in Wallsend Borough being the land omprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG.1 in the Register of Town or Village reens maintained by the Northumberland County Council of which no person is registered nder section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Wallsend Borough Council laimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed o have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership. f the land at Newcastle upon Tyne on 4 April 1973. No person attended the hearing to laim ownership.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of he land, and I shall accordingly direct the Northumberland County Council, as egistration authority, to register Wallsend Borough Council as the owner of the land nder section 8(3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to xplain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law ay, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, equire me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
