COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 239/D/12

In the Matter of Four Pieces of Land situate adjacent to and opposite the School, Idlicote, Warwickshire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 89 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Warwickshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 46 made by Mr R P G Dill and noted in the Register on 21 June 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Leamington Spa on 7 December 1982. The hearing was attended by Mrs J Smith, Solicitor, on behalf of the Stratford-on-Avon District Council.

The application for the registration was made by the former Shipston-on-Stour Rural Listrict Council. On 4 November 1971 the Clerk of that Council wrote to the Clerk of the former Warwickshire County Council stating that it was desired to modify the registration so as to include only two of the four pieces of land the subject of the application, but no action was taken to amend the registration.

Mrs Smith informed me that it was now desired to remove another piece of land from the registration, leaving only a triangular area at a road junction, and that the Objector did not object to the inclusion of this area. The evidence that this area falls within the definition of "town or village green" in section 22(1) of the Commons Registration Act 1965 is minimal, being no more than it is known in the locality as "The Green", and the statutory declaration in support of the application made by Mr R S Anker, but since there is no longer any objection to the registration of the area, I confirm the registration with the following modification, namely, the exclusion of all the land other than the triangular area at the road junction.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
