

In the Matter of Freasley Common, Dordon, Warwickshire (No. 2)

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1 to 8 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 18 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Warwickshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 33 made by the National Coal Board and noted in the Register on 21 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Nuneaton on 13 October 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr G S Dormond, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 5, and the National Coal Board was represented by Mr A K Simmons, its agent.

For the reasons stated in my decision in In the Matter of Freasley Common, Dordon (No. 1) (1983), Ref. No. 239/D/32 I have confirmed the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of the Register Unit with the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection. There being no other objection to the registrations the subject of this reference, I confirm those registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
