

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of The Green, Sawbridge,  
Wolfhampcote, Warwickshire (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 47 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Warwickshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 119 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Rugby on 10 November 1982. The hearing was attended by Mr F B Campion. Mr Campion produced a copy of an objection, dated 23 July 1972, which he had made to the registration, but no note of which appears on the Register.

There was no appearance on behalf of the Wolfhampcote Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, but Solicitors acting for the Parish Council informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by letter dated 2 November 1982 that it was not proposed to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
