



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 45/1/234 1978

In the Matter of Part of Prince of Wales Park
Bingley Bradford City Council

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as part of Prince of Wales Park Bingley Bradford City Council being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG.134 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former West Riding County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Bradford City Council claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Bradford on 25 January 1978.

Mr Pepper appeared for the Bradford City Council.

The land in question allotment No.134 on the map referred to, the Bingley (on Gilstead Moor) Inclosure Award of 1861 was by the said award and by an order for the Inclosure Commissioners dated 1 January 1863 ~~was~~ allotted to the Church Wardens and Overseers of the poor for recreational purposes. In the events which have happened the land in question is now vested in the Bradford City Council as the successor to the Official Trustee of Charity Lands and then the Bingley U D C.

On this evidence I am satisfied that Bradford City Council is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the West Yorkshire County Council, as registration authority, to register Bradford City Council as the owner of the land under section 8 (2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
