

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of the land known as Brow Moor  
in the Township of Haworth, Keighley

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 4 (now 11 para 1) in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 1 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former West Riding County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1676 made by Craven Water Board and noted in the Register on 5 June 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bradford on 10 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr R Simpson an Assistant Solicitor for the Yorkshire Water Authority the successor to Craven Water Board. Messrs Walker, Charlesworth and Foster, Solicitors of Skipton had written to the Commons Commissioners on 22 January 1981 stating that their clients Percy and Ellenor Howarth had agreed to withdraw their registration of a right to water.

For these reasons I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely the deletion of para 1.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
