



In the Matter of the Land known as
Ramsden Hill, Todmorden

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land and Ownership sections of Register Unit No. CL 676 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 335 and 228 made by L R Greenwood and noted in the Register on 31 May 1972 and 3 May 1972 respectively.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bradford on 11 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr Wright of Messrs Hartley, Thomas and Wright, Solicitors of Rochdale who appeared for the applicant Mr J P Dearden.

Mr Wright informed me that his client withdrew both his applications and asked me not to confirm either registration.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm either registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
