



In the Matter of the piece of land known as G. has
Gate Hetholunoyd

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.252 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former West Riding County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 432 made by Wakefield and District Water Board and noted in the Register on 4 January 1971 and to the registration at Entry Nos. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of the same Register Unit in the same Register occasioned by Objection No. 432 made by the said Water Board and noted on the Register on 4 January 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bradford on 11 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr R Simpson, Solicitor for the Yorkshire Water Authority and Mr Sunderland in person.

Mr Simpson informed me that both applicants had accepted the objection of the authority's predecessor, the former Wakefield and District Water Board.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations in the land and rights section with the following modification that the land shown hatched red on the plan attached to objection No. 432 dated 29 September 1970 be excluded from the registration in the Land Section.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
