DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land and Ownership sections of Register Unit No. VG 165 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former West Riding County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1519 and 1518 both made by E G and Mrs Y B Jackson and both noted in the Register on 11 January 1981.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bradford on 12 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr J S Brodwell instructed by Messrs Harrison, Solicitors of Leeds for Thornber Parish Council and Mr P Hurst instructed by Messrs Bateson, Coates and Co, Solicitors of Leeds for Mr and Mrs T N Balmer the successors-in-title to the original objectors. After the application had been opened the parties requested a short adjournment. When the parties had agreed as follows. The objection was withdrawn and I was asked to confirm the registration in the Land Section except for any part used as a highway. There was no objection registered in respect of any highway.

For these reasons I confirm the registration in the Land Section but not the registration in the Ownership section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
