

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 241/D/41 and 42

In the Matter of Marston Green, Marston, Kennet D

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and the deemed Entries 1 to 10 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL.85 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Wiltshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG. 13 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Trowbridge on 30 June 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr P Tram the Secretary to the Farston Green Trustees who registered the land in question both as a Village Green and as Common Land. Mr Oram requested me to refuse to confirm the Entry in the Land Section as a village green and I have by a decision under Reference No 241/D/40 relating to Unit No VG. 13 refused to confirm that Entry. I confirm the Entry No 11 in the Land Section of Unit No CL. 85.

Entry Nos 1 to 10 in the Rights Section of Unit No VG. 13 are deemed to be Entries in the Rights Section of Unit No CL. 85 and I confirm these Entries as Entries in the Rights Section of Unit No CL. 85.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
