

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos.241/D/14 241/D/16

In the Matter of The Green, Woodford, Wiltshire (No.2).

## **DECISION**

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG 36 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Wiltshire County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL 2 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council and by Objection No.56 made by Mr H.M.Parker and noted in the Register on 5th April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Salisbury on 26th February 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr R.Wilkinson, the Clerk of the Woodford Parish Council, the applicant for both the registration and the conflicting registration and by Mr Parker in person.

Mr Wilkinson said that, while the Parish Council had applied for both registrations, he sought to support only the registration as common land.

In these circumstances I can only refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
