



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 260/D/221

In the Matter of Two small additional pieces  
of land at Lyde Green, Pucklechurch, Avon (No.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry No. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.G/CL 393 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. Ob.658 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council and duly noted in the Register.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 19 July 1983. The hearing was attended by Miss B Jenkins Evans, Solicitor, on behalf of the Avon County Council, the successor authority of the Objector. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mrs Mabel Higgins and Mr S J Waycott, the applicants for the registration.

The Objection relates to only a small area of land which has been excluded from the Register Unit by my decision in In the Matter of Two Small Additional Pieces of Land at Lyde Green, Pucklechurch (No.1) (1983) Ref.No. 260/D/220.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
