



In the Matter of Victoria Park and Waterloo Wharf, Pill,
Easton-in-Gordano, Avon.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 98 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Somerset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 0/207 made by the former County Council and noted in the Register on 29 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Weston-super-Mare on 19 October 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr G W Duck, a member of the Easton-in-Gordano Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and Mr A James, solicitor, on behalf of the Avon County Council, the successor authority of the Objector.

The Objection relates to only two small areas. Mr James said that he did not wish to proceed with the Objection in so far as it related to the more northerly of the two areas and Mr Duck stated that he did not support the registration in so far as it related to the more southerly area.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely the exclusion of the more southerly area of land the subject of the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
