DECISION

his dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register nit No. VG 96 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Berkshire ounty Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 155 made by Mr J N Sheffield and noted n the Register on 16 February 1971.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispite at Windsor on 13 December 978. The hearing was attended by Commander D B Cairns, the Honorary Secretary of the wyford and Ruscombe Residents Association, the applicant for the registration, and by r A J Southorn, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr Alan Godsal, on whose behalf Mr Sheffield ade the Objection.
