

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 51/D/56 & 57

In the Matter of Part of Ruabon Mountain, Rhos, Wrexham Maelor BC

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 266 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 151 made by Wrexham & East Denbighshire Water Company and noted in the Register on 28 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangollen on 6 December 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Edwards of Hessrs Walker Smith & Way on behalf of the Water Company.

The Unit Land is 1.6 acres and useless for grazing and no one present at the hearing contended that I should do otherwise than refuse to confirm the registrations.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
