



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.206/D/3

In the Matter of Tredinnick Downs Common,  
St.Columb and St.Issey, Cornwall (No.3).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 251 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.X 341 made by Mr G.Hawke and Mr L.B.Hawke and noted in the Register on 24th March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 13th March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mrs N.Brewer, the personal representative of Mr W.Salmon, one of the applicants for the registration, Mr R.M.Brewer, the other applicant for the registration, and Mr M.Hartley, solicitor, on behalf of the Objectors.

The Objection relates solely to an area of land, consisting of a quarry, shown on the plan annexed to the Objection. I have confirmed the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of the Register Unit subject to the exclusion of the land shown on this plan, so it now only remains for me to confirm the registration the subject of this dispute.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
