

In the Matter of Anthorn and Cardurnock Marshes, Bowness, Cumbria (No. 2)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 496 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 211 made by Ms F J Drydale and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Keswick on 10 November 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J Fryer Spedding, of counsel, on behalf of the Earl of Lonsdale, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr J D Claxton, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

 ${\tt Mr}$  Fryer Spedding informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration,

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
