

In the Matter of Bolton Fell, Hethersgill, Cumbria (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 464 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 119 made by the Hethersgill Parish Council and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 8 April 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr P Rigby, solicitor, on behalf of Mr M C Halton and Mr A D Duncan, the applicants for the registration, and by Mr J Mawson, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

Mr Rigby informed me that he had been instructed not to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
