



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. B/U/90

In the Matter of Highnam Green
Gloucester City Council

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Highnam Green Gloucester City Council being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG.56 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Mr T J Fenton claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Gloucester on 17th February 1976.

Mr T J Fenton appeared in person and produced an ascent to him dated 30th January 1975 made by Barclays Bank Ltd and W J Wilkin as the personal Representatives of T M G Parry deceased whereby the land in question (identified by a plan ¹⁵⁶ ~~52~~ the ¹⁵⁶ ~~consent~~) was vested in him.

On this evidence I am satisfied that Mr T J Fenton is the owner of the land and I shall accordingly direct the Gloucestershire County Council, as registration authority, to register as the owner of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965)

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, with 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
