



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Headley Village Green
Headley East Hants D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.92 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. OB 588 made by Hampshire County Council and noted in the Register on 19 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 25 July 1979. The hearing was attended by Miss A Craig on behalf of Hampshire County Council, Mr T Willis on behalf of Headley Parish Council and Mr F J Osgood the applicant.

Miss Craig withdrew the County Councils objection without prejudice to its right to contend that part of the land was not only part of the Village Green but also part of a highway.

For this reason I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
