



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Ludshott Common,
in the Parishes of Bramshott and
Grayshott, East Hampshire D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos 2, 3 and 4 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 101 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No OB 704 made by The National Trust and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 5 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr J Trimmer of Messrs W Bradley Trimmer & Co on behalf of the National Trust. None of the applicants for Rights appeared and I therefore accede to Mr Trimmer's invitation to refuse to confirm Entry No 3 and to confirm Entry Nos 2 and 4 modified as follows:-

Entry No 2 by deleting all the words in column 4 and substituting therefor the words "a right to graze 3 cattle and a right of estovers"

Entry No 4 by deleting all the words in column 4 and substituting therefor the words "a right to graze 20 cattle and a right of estovers".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
