

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 21/D/33

In the Matter of Village Green or Fish Pool, Breedon-on-the-Hill, Northwest Leicestershire District, Leicestershire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG. 53 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Leicestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 24 made by Mr David Arthur Gillies Shields and noted in the Register on 2 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Leicester on 22 July 1976. At the hearing Breedon-on-the-Hill Parish Council, on whose application the registration was made, were represented by Mr R A Frain, Northwest Leicestershire District Council were represented by Mr M R Sutcliffe, barrister-at-law, their Secretary, and Mr William E Smith the Parish Council chairman when the registration was made, was present. I adjourned the proceedings at the request of Mr Sutcliff; he having said that this had been agreed telephonically by Mr Crane of Crane & Walton Solicitors of Ashby de la Zouche, and Mr Frain having agreed.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, such terms dated 11 October 1976 being that the Commons Commissioner do confirm the registration as to the land edged green on the plan annexed thereto and do refuse to confirm the registration as to the land coloured red on the said plan.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the modification that the land coloured red on the plan annexed to the terms dated 11 October 1976 to remove from the legister.
