

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 222/U/11

In the Matter of a lane off High Street, Ingoldmells, Lincolnshire

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as a lane off High Street, Ingoldmells, Lincolnshire being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 27 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lincolnshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in cuestion and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Lincoln on 30 November 1978.

At the hearing Ingoldmells Parish Council appeared by its Clerk, Mr E L Haywood. Parish Council put in no evidence to support any claim to ownership.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965. (may, within b weeks of the from the delemental notice of the clearison is sent to him
