In the Matter of The Common, Scrooby

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry No.1 in the Land Section and Entry Nos. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 27 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Nottinghamshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 2 and 19 made by Mrs O S Insall and noted in the Register on 22 December 1970 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 72 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Nottingham on 30 October 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr M J Dolby, Chairman of Scrooby Parish Council and Mr P Cawley on behalf of his wife and himself as successors in title of Mrs Insall.

The hearing had been adjourned on two previous occasions namely, 13 January 1981 and 1 February 1983.

The application in the Land Section was withdrawn and no one appeared in support of the applications in the Rights Section.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm any of the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
