



In the Matter of the pieces of land known
as Parish Watering Place, Collingham

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land and Ownership section of Register Unit No. VG 136 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former West Riding County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1638 and 1637 both made by J D Paterson and noted in the Register on 14 and 13 April 1972 respectively and by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CE 432 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bradford on 12 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr N Dyson of Messrs Fitzgerald Harts, Solicitors of Wetherby on behalf of Collingham with Linton Parish Council. Mr Dyson informed me that his clients and the objectors had agreed that the applications for registration as common land and a village green should be withdrawn.

For these reasons I confirm either registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
